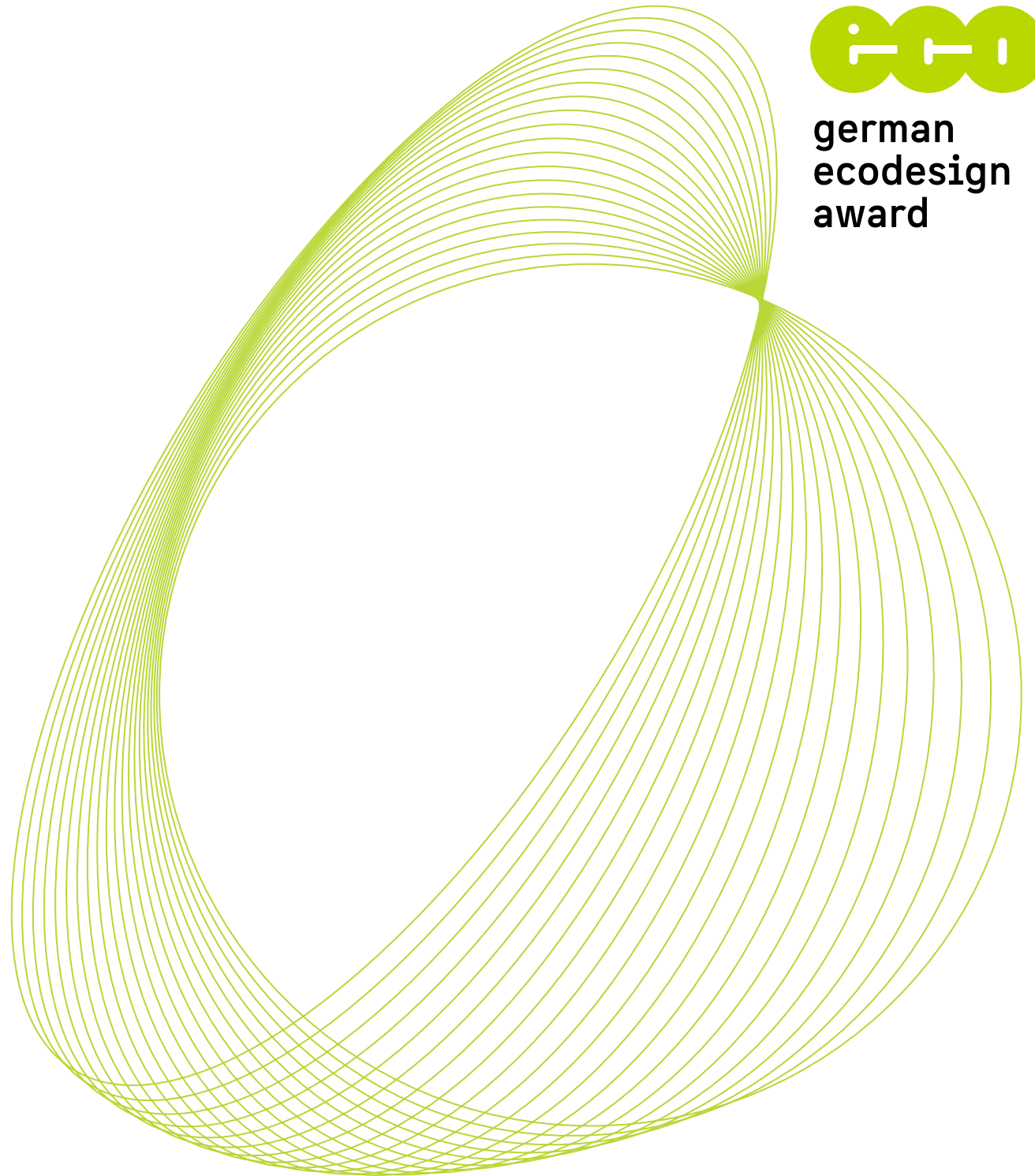

Award

The Federal Ministry for the Environment and the German Environment Agency present the German Ecodesign Award annually in cooperation with the International Design Center Berlin. The competition is aimed at companies of all sectors and sizes as well as design agencies, architecture and engineering firms, research institutes and students. The award is granted in the following categories: Service, Concept, Product and Young Talent.

Multistage assessment procedure

Experts of the German Environment Agency and the project advisory board examine the ecological and design quality of the submissions and decide on admission to the jury session. The interdisciplinary jury selects the nominees and award winners. Innovation, design quality and environmental characteristics are the key factors in the assessment.

Jury session and exhibition in Berlin

All entries selected for the jury session are presented to the public in an exhibition at the Metropolenhaus Berlin.

Award ceremony

At the award ceremony at the Federal Ministry for the Environment, the award winners receive a certificate and trophy as well as the right to use the official logo for marketing purposes. Additional cash prizes are awarded in the Young Talent category.

Touring exhibition

The nominated and award-winning projects will be presented in a touring exhibition the following year. A catalogue will be published accompanying the exhibition.

Video

Each award-winning project will be presented in a video clip. It will be displayed in the touring exhibition and the online gallery and can be used by the award winners and the press.
